



PREPARING AN

EMERGENCY KIT OR BACKPACK

Preparing for possible disasters that may affect our communities will be a little different than in other years. The **American Red Cross** recommends the following tips when preparing an emergency preparedness kit or backpack.

- Make 2 kits & remember to renew them every 6 months.
- ♦ Each member of the family should have their own kit or backpack.
- Customize kits to meet everyone's personal needs based on the disasters that are prevalent in your area.
- Pack pet supplies.

1. Stay-At-Home Kit:

Include everything you need to stay home for at least 2 weeks with items such as food, water, cleaning & sanitizing supplies, soap, paper products & toiletries.

2. 3-Day Emergency Preparedness Kit:

The second kit should be a smaller, lightweight version that you can take with you if you need to leave your home guickly.

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WHAT TO INCLUDE IN A 3-DAY EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT:

- ♦ Non-perishable food & water
- ♦ Personal hygiene items
- ♦ Cleaning & disinfection supplies (tissues, 60% alcohol hand sanitizer, sanitizing towels)
- Cloth face coverings for everyone in your home
- ♦ Diaper rash cream, bottles, baby wipes
- ♦ Pet food & extra water for your pet
- ♦ Cash or traveler's checks
- Important family documents (copies of insurance policies, IDs & account records stored electronically or in a sealed waterproof plastic bag)
- ♦ 1 month supply of prescription drugs and over-the-counter medications in a separate container (i.e. cough syrups, fever-reducing medications & medical supplies)
